


Sweeping across the site from the gateway building on the Gortin Road, a central boulevard takes students through the heart of the campus. Each school has their own unique site adjacent to the boulevard, which is punctuated by the state of the art School of Activity and Shared Educational Hub.

Shared Education Hub

The Shared Education Hub is a unique asset to the campus. All schools have invested resources to create a learning environment rich in imaginative spaces, unique teaching environments and innovative philosophy.

This area is particularly aimed at promoting independent learning amongst the post 16 pupils on campus. The building will cover areas like technology and design; music; drama; art; science; home economics and sixth form study.

The Shared Education Hub sits in the heart of the campus, making it accessible to all students and an inspiring community environment to be in.

School of Activity

The School of Activity offers the opportunity to unlock the potential of sports and activity facilities through sharing between all of the schools. The school will include a large sports complex; multiple courts; a covered multi-use games area; and spectator seating.
