


Christian Brothers Grammar School occupies a prominent site in the campus on the approach avenue from the site entrance on the Strathroy Road to the Boulevard. The School defines the boundary of its own site and its triple height entrance portal helps mark the important public realm space in front.

The centralised multi-purpose hall and the two flanking internal landscaped courtyards give a confident order to the internal layout on all levels. The Dining Space has been closely aligned to the multi-purpose Hall and gives definition to these large important resource spaces at the heart of the School on the ground floor level.

On each floor level, the clustering of specialist subject rooms around the learning resource centres, reflects the changing educational landscape with trends towards more flexible, independent and resource based teaching modes based on the potential of new technologies.

The proposed layout is focused on maximizing use of available space. This offers curriculum flexibility within formal and informal spaces enabling personal and group study opportunities.
