
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Omagh High School is located at the beginning of the Boulevard, immediately behind the future Gateway Building. It is a three storey building accessed at upper ground floor level. The dining hall is located centrally at the heart of the plan at lower ground floor level and is nestled within a full height atrium naturally lit from above and is allowed to spill out onto the playground at this level.

The Music Department is located on the entrance level across from the multi-purpose hall. A STEM environment is created at the lower ground floor level through the co-location of Technology and Design, Art and Design and Science. The remainder of the teaching accommodation has been placed over 3 floors, in response to a series of detailed design workshops with the Principal and the Senior Management Team.


Sited short side onto the boulevard and needing to respond to a significant change in levels the school uses this to its advantage.

A large entrance foyer rises to the full height of the building, forming a unique dining area within the atrium. Light floods through the void, bringing natural light deep into the plan.


