



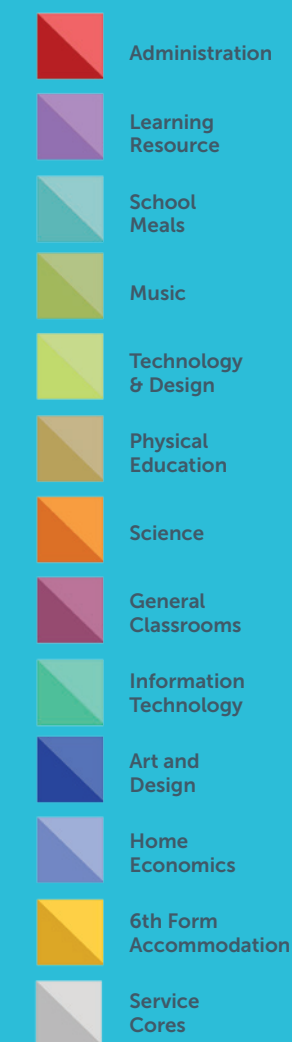
In the middle of the boulevard and with a sloping site the Omagh Academy Grammar School concept responds to the design opportunities to create a unique learning experience.

Entering at Upper ground level users will enjoy a view across the Strule towards Omagh through the glazed atrium from which they can move up or down. Accomodation from Lower Ground Floor has been repositioned atop the building, creating an impressive 3 storey frontage to the boulevard and a magnificent outdoor terrace at upper levels enjoying vistas across the landscape.

Classrooms have been grouped to take advantage of educational synergies and promote an integrative learning environment throughout the school.

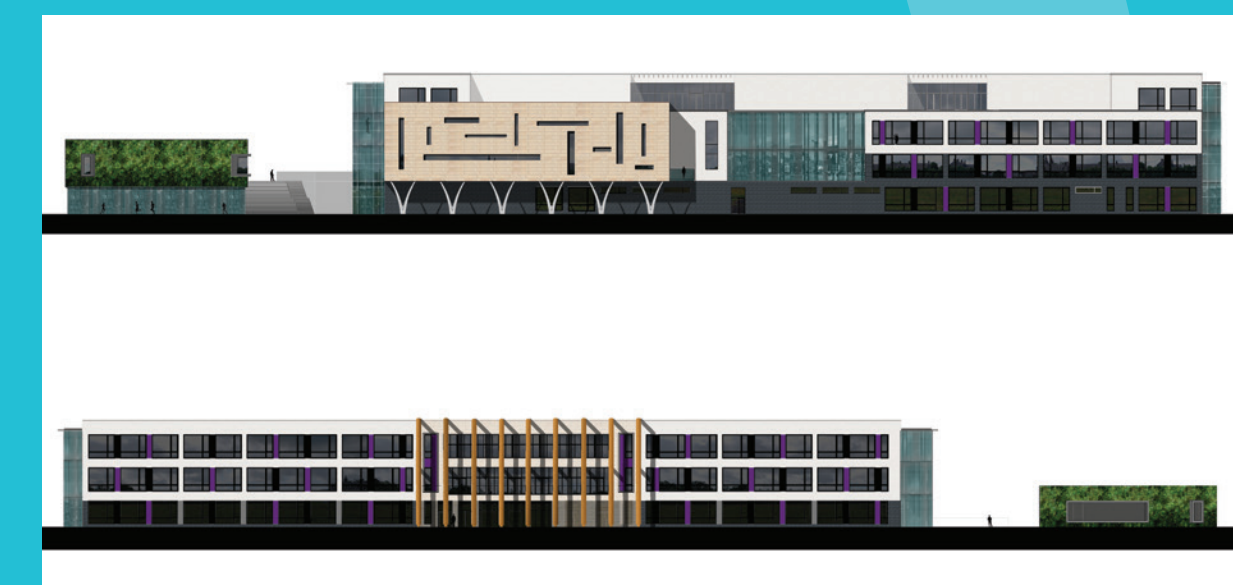
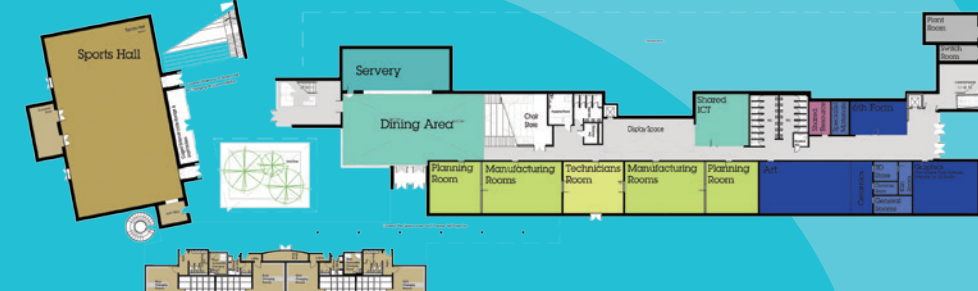
First Floor
